

How to export a .ged file from Ancestry

What is a .ged file ?

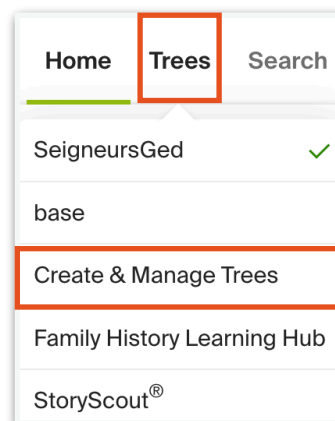
GEDCOM is a file format specifically designed for the transfer of genealogical data between different systems, software, or genealogy websites. It can be written in various formats (ASCII, ANSEL, UTF-8, UTF-16, ISO-8859-1, etc.).

We recommend exporting and importing .ged files in UTF-8 format. This format ensures the correct reading of special characters (accents, cedillas, etc.).

How to export your .ged file ?

Log in to your Ancestry account.
On your homepage, click on the **Trees** menu, then on **Create & Manage trees**.

Select the tree you want to export and click on **Tree settings**.

Once your export is ready, click on the Download button.
